

Early Childhood Education Program Criteria

Enrollment Criteria for ALL Programs:

- 1. Child must be 3 years old on or before December 1st of the current school year.
- 2. Child require preschool/children's center attendance due to special family circumstances (CPS referral, or In Transition, etc.)
- 3. Family Income and/or need
- 4. IEP Participation

Admission Criteria for Part-Day Preschool Programs:

- Admission priority will be given to qualifying families using the above listed enrollment criteria
- Families are required to meet the State guidelines for income eligibility or meet specific IEP participation guidelines.
- Children must be 3 years old on or before December 1st of the current school year.

Admission Criteria for Full-Day Preschool Programs:

- Admission priority will be given to qualifying families using the above listed enrollment criteria
- Families must meet the state guidelines for income AND need eligibility.
- Children must be 3 years old on or before December 1st of the current school year.

Admission Criteria for Infant/Toddler Program

- Admission priority will be given to qualifying families using the above listed enrollment criteria, in the order given
- Families must meet the state guideline for income AND need eligibility.
- Parents enrolled in High School will be given first priority.

Admission Criteria for Head Start Programs

- Income guidelines are determined by the Federal Office of Head Start
- Admission priority will be given to qualifying families using the above listed enrollment criteria.
- Children must be 3 years old on or before December 1st of the current school year.

Admission Criteria for Early Head Start Programs

- The Twin Rivers Early Head Start Preschool is a federally-funded program for low-income children ages 24 to 36 months.
- Income guidelines are determined by the Federal Office of Head Start.
- Admission priority will be given to qualifying families using the above listed enrollment criteria.
