Mathematics placement shall be based on objective measures. These measures may include:

- District Benchmark Assessments, District Unit Assessments
- Standardized tests that reflect statewide mathematics assessments (SBAC) math scores
- Student grades that reflect comprehension and mastery of the subject matter, from grading periods of the 6th, 7th, 8th, and 9th grades
- Other objective indicators of student performance and proficiency in mathematics such as: Teacher created assessments, in class assignments and projects

Note: Three years of High School Math are required for graduation. Three years (four years recommended) of high school math with a grade of “C” or better are required to apply for a UC or CSU
