To our Twin Rivers Family,

As educators, we are called to this line of work to positively impact the lives of students and the families we serve, and the foundation of that is providing a safe place for students to learn to support them in achieving their potential.

I am angered and deeply troubled by the allegations that an employee in our district has allegedly taken advantage of a position of trust to harm children. I, like many of you, as a parent and educator, trust that when our kids go to school, they will be surrounded by educators who are trustworthy and keep them safe.

Like you, I want answers, so I am sharing with you what we currently know, and what actions have been taken.

In 2019, the Sacramento Police Department received a call of allegations of inappropriate conduct involving a staff member at Del Paso Heights Elementary. The investigation was ultimately suspended by the Sacramento Police Department.

On Jan. 11, 2023, the district learned from a third party—unrelated to law enforcement or Twin Rivers Unified School District (TRUSD)—of alleged misconduct involving Kim Wilson and immediately placed Mr. Wilson on administrative leave. On Jan. 20, 2023, the district was notified of his arrest by the Sacramento Police Department.

We are cooperating fully with the Sacramento Police Department in its current and ongoing investigation. TRUSD has also complied with California Commission on Teacher Credentialing reporting requirements and is taking decisive employment action consistent with the law.

I want to reiterate that under no circumstances does the district condone or tolerate inappropriate behavior directed at our students. We encourage anyone with information about Mr. Wilson to report it immediately to the Sacramento Police Department at (916) 808-0170.

We will continue to provide updates as they become available in accordance with the ongoing investigation.

Finally, we understand and acknowledge the impact this has had on our Twin Rivers family. With that in mind, we are currently offering mental health resources for students and families through Twin Rivers' Crisis Intervention Team and [Care Solace](#).
