To Staff and the Twin Rivers School Community,

I write to you today with conflicted emotions. I'm thrilled to have our students and staff back from Winter Break, but I'm also deeply saddened that we tragically lost one of our students during that time. Ten-year-old Keith Frierson was fatally shot Dec. 30, 2023. KJ, as he was affectionately known, attended Strauch Elementary. My heart aches for his family and loved ones.

My heart also aches for KJ's classmates and teachers who are having a difficult time. Our Crisis Intervention Team—counselors and chaplains—have been at Strauch visiting classrooms, answering questions and concerns, and talking with students in groups and individually as they grieve and express their feelings about this senseless tragedy. Additional supports were also provided at Woodridge as many students in the Woodridge school community also knew KJ and his family. I can't thank the team enough for taking such good care of our Strauch students and staff as they work through their feelings of shock, sadness and confusion.

Our sincere condolences to the family and all who knew and loved KJ. It will take time to heal, but we will get through this together.
