

Smart Planning for Stronger Schools

- Twin Rivers developed a Long-Range Master Plan that serves as a guide to prioritize investments in our facilities with a focus on the safety and standardization of our existing infrastructure for those facilities most in need.
- Aligned with the forward-thinking and fiscally responsible approach, Twin Rivers is prioritizing our facilities planning into four categories of: Must Do, Should Do, Would Like to Do, and Future.
- Twin Rivers is investing more than **\$303 Million** in ongoing facilities and maintenance projects using existing funding, on projects in progress or planning to commence during the 2023-2024 fiscal year.


At Twin Rivers Elementary Schools



Investing in our students and community

- Twin Rivers encompasses 52 school sites 29 elementary, 5 middle, 4 comprehensive high schools, 3 charters at 7 sites, and 7 alternative schools.
- More than 87% of the facilities utilized to serve students and our communities are over 40 years old, including 44% which have been in use for more than six decades.
