

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING COVID-19 TESTING



Effective February 29, 2024, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has announced the at-home testing program will be coming to an end.

HOW TO GET TESTED



TWIN RIVERS UNIFIED

TRUSD will provide test kits until sources have been depleted and/or tests have reached their expiration date



LOCAL PHARMACIES

Pharmacies such as CVS and Walgreens provide in-store testing at low or no cost for insured and uninsured patients. Medi-Cal patients can receive free testing kits at any pharmacy with a valid Medi-Cal card



PRIVATE INSURANCE

Most private insurance companies will pay for or reimburse the cost of up to 8 test kits per month. Follow up with your insurance company for more details



TESTING CENTERS & FREE TESTS

WE CARE ABOUT YOUR HEALTH

Eligible organizations, such as TRUSD, are able to place orders for COVID-19 testing kits up until the February 29 cutoff date. A back order of tests has been ordered by Health Services, and will be distributed to school sites on an as needed basis. Once testing kits have been depleted, please utilize the other testing resources listed above.
